
On Wednesday September 30, 2009, Integrated Risk Management Associates, LLC did a field inspection at the Citizens First Credit Union, located at Hwy 44 & Universal Street, Oshkosh Wisconsin. Our report and recommendations follow:

I arrived on-site at 11:00 am. Checked in at the Miron Construction Trailer and talked to Matt, Project Manager for Miron Construction. He reported that Muza employees were always completely tied-off and that he was very happy with their performance.

George was the foreman, and Troy was helping out on the project. There were several employees on the roof removing asphalt shingles and dropping them into Muza Trucks. All of the areas around the trucks were properly barricaded with CAUTION tape. All of the employees on the roof were wearing harnesses and properly tied-off. There were numerous tie-off anchors installed into the roof. Muza Trucks # 17, 123, and 124 were on-site.

No discrepancies were found.
