Dear Carven,

On Friday, September 11, 2009, Integrated Risk Management Associates, LLC did a field inspection at A Loft Hotel, 1230 N. Old World Third Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Our report and recommendations follow:

Robin had inspected the site on Wednesday, September 9, 2009. He had recommended that the disposable anchors being used be replaced with permanent anchors, and that a fire extinguisher, first aid kit, and extra body harness be placed in the job trailer.

I arrived at the site at 10:10 am and checked in at the Horizons Construction trailer. I found Greg and Jason working from a ledge on the southwest wall. They were approximately 5 stories high. (See Photos 1, 2 & 3)

The disposable anchors had been replaced with vertical anchor brackets mounted to the wall. A fire extinguisher, first aid kit, and extra body harness had been placed in the job trailer. (See Photo 4) Muza truck #125 was fully equipped.

No discrepancies were found.

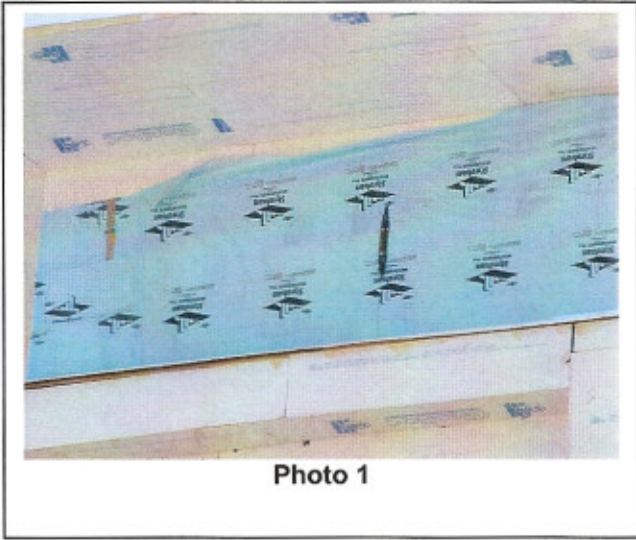

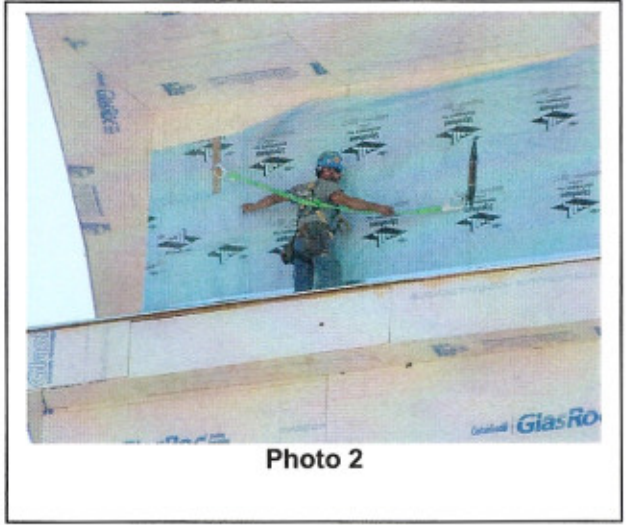

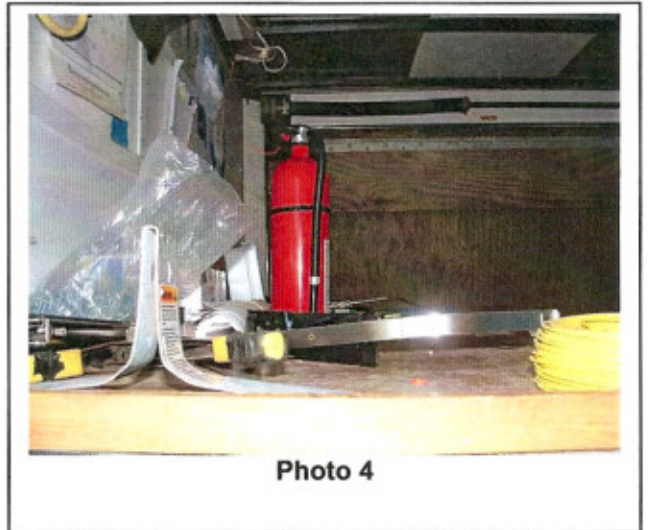
